Sports Coaching £210	- 4/5 weeks of a one hour session after-school sports club for pupils with qualified sports coach OR 4/5 x 1 hour sports coaching sessions, working alongside a Primary Teacher/T.A. to learn from the Coach. Ideally after-school, or sometimes in curriculum time)
Sports Council £315	- Sports Council help to set this up and train pupils at your school and instigate the first meeting (6-7 hours approx.)
Young Leaders/Sports Crew training £270	- Young Leaders programme of training (Sports Leaders UK recognised) 6-7 hours approx. including certificates (for years 5/6 or adapted Mini Leaders for year 2's)
Howard SSP Primary P.E. Assessment tool £300 K.S. 1 and 2 £200 K.S. 2 £100 K.S. 1	- Memory-stick including all grids to help Primary Teachers track their class of pupils progress, in all areas of the P.E. curriculum (activity specific). Using the current terminology (emerging, expected, exceeding) this is an in-depth tool that can be used to help plan lessons, identify where pupils are at in their P.E. learning, identifying who is/is not making progress, and providing evidence to feedback to pupils/parents and Ofsted/your line managers.

CPD in depth support/team teaching £540	- More in depth P.E. CPD support for your Teachers through SSSCo/Trainer visit: 2 days (12 hours max) as required. For example team teaching gymnastics for 10-12 lessons with less experienced primary teachers
Gifted and Talented training £270	- Gifted and Talented Assessment training for teachers. SSSCo to assist Teachers on how to assess pupils in P.E. (using Kent Assessment framework) and help you to review your schools G and T policy/help to put one in place. 1 day/6hours
Using sport as a tool £540	- Sport as tool to focus on literacy/maths/geography/languages etc. This cross curricular project is flexible (2xSSCo day's/12hours max) - Sport as a tool to engage pupils or to help improve low self-esteem/physically inactive/obese/behavioural issues with your pupils etc. (2xSSCo day's/12 hours max.)

<p>Gifted and Talented coaching camps after-school £110 per primary school entry</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For years 1-4 for 4-5 x one hour after-school coaching sessions. Fee is charged per school whether the school enters 1 or 4 pupils- max. recommended G and T pupil entries per session (need min. 15 pupils and max. 30 pupils per session across a group of schools). Multi-Skill and sports coaching is delivered by qualified sports coaches and P.E. Teachers on a Secondary School site.
<p>Primary School year group Sports and Physical Activity Day at local secondary school sports site £150 per school</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Primary School enters one whole class of children (Year Group TBC) attend a 'Have a Go' at various sports with coaching in one day. Where children have a go at various sports, on a secondary school site with P.E. Teachers, Coaches and student sport leaders (minimum 6- 8 classes/schools required)
<p>Sports Mentor in your school £1500</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Similar to a special Teaching Assistant in lessons and playtime/lunchtimes as required to assist with behaviour/whole school standards i.e. Maths and English through sports projects. <u>5 whole day visits.</u>
<p>International Sports Performer/V.I.P. school visit £800</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Secure an international Sports Performer/VIP for a whole day at your school - to help inspire pupils to take up sport/healthy lifestyle and learn about athlete's achievements and work ethic.
<p>One off Staff INSET training in a P.E. area £500 for the whole day, £360 for the half day and £150 for a twilight period (1.5 hours)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A specialist P.E. tutor delivers a training course (plus resources) appropriate for your staff as part of your school INSET. This can be for a whole day/half day or 1.5 hours after-school. - We will do our best to find a member of staff or suitable external tutor to deliver this request on a date and time suitable to your school staff members. This course would be in addition/extra to the annual HSSP CPD programme of courses and open to your school staff.
<p>Provision of School Teacher specialising in P.E. £13,200 (one whole day or £6,600 for half day provision team teaching)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For one whole school day each week throughout the whole academic year and assisting other classroom teachers through team teaching the P.E. curriculum. Or one half day each week throughout the academic year - £6,600. - If your school only wants this service for one term (i.e. max. 6 weeks) weekly for half a day, the team teaching this will cost £1100
