Team Information:

- A Primary team must consist of a minimum 6 boys and 6 girls - Total of 12 year 1 and 2's
- One team per school max. per age group

Equipment:

- All equipment is provided for each event, please ensure pupils arrive in P.E. kit.
- Student sport leaders will stand at each skills station do a demonstration, instruct and assist primary pupils on how to 'have a go' at specific athletics events.
- Participants should wear appropriate sportswear and footwear for the indoor sports hall.

Playing Rules:

- There will be 4 themed areas: Movement, Balance, Co-ordination and Aiming and within each area there will be 3 skills station to have a go at.
- Each child will gain either a Bronze/Silver or Gold individual certificate for participating depending upon how many points they gained.
- One boy and one girl from each team will be awarded an Endeavour Award/small trophy (nominated by Teacher's in charge of team) to encourage: Fair Play, Hard Work, Team work and good sportsmanship.
