General:

- There will be 8-10 indoor Tri Golf holes at Medway Park sports hall. All equipment will be provided. For copies of the content of each hole contact Festival organiser.
- A team must consist of 6 boys and 6 girls from years 3 and 4.
- Entries will not be accepted after the closing date.
- Teachers are at all times responsible for the behaviour and conduct of the participants and supporters.
- Staff, sport leaders and officials should be treated with respect at all times.
- Referees and organisers decisions are final and should be accepted at all times.
- Teachers will be asked to assist throughout the day.

Team Information:

- Teams must consist of 12 pupils max. (6 girls and 6 boys) from years 3 and 4.
- One Team per school max.

Equipment:

- All equipment for each golf hole (target areas/obstacles/water holes/hoops etc) will be provided.
- Plastic putters and pitching wedges will be provided for both right-handed and left handed pupils.
- Student sport leaders will stand at each hole and do a demonstration and instruct pupils on how to 'have a go' at Tri Golf and score each child.
- Participants should wear appropriate sportswear and footwear for the indoor sports hall.

Playing Rules:

- Each child will 'have go' at each of the 8-10 holes. All abilities welcomed.
- School teams given safety advice when swinging clubs i.e. all other team players need to sit down in the safety zone and away from the one pupil that is swinging/having a go. Plus the walk way down the middle of the hall is the safe zone for pupils waiting to have their go.
- Each child from each school team will gain points - calculated by the student sport leader and these will be inputted on the computer to give a total score for each school team and ultimately a total team score and final placing's.
- A Fair Play Award will be awarded according to feedback from sport leaders and Festival organisers based upon positive behaviour, good sportsmanship and team spirit on the day.
