## **IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDING**

- There will be two security guards at every event wearing hi viz.
- ALL teams have to wear a team kit, ideally with school logo on it so they can easily be identified. Preferably not their regular PE kit, if no team kit is available ALL players must wear their school PE kit AND matching
- When you register your team in the morning each player will have a SSG hand stamp.
- All spectators must sign in at the entrance to Medway Park and will have to wear a sticker.

We need to make each team/player/spectator easily identifiable so all staff can challenge any person who does not meet the above criteria.





#### General:

- There will be two separate competitions running on the day, one for boys and one for girls.
- Entries will not be accepted after the closing date.
- Teachers are at all times responsible for the behaviour and conduct of the participants and supporters.
- Staff and officials should be treated with respect at all times.
- Referees and organisers decisions are final and should be accepted at all times.
- Teachers will be asked to assist throughout the day.

#### **Team Information:**

- Teams must consist of maximum 10 pupils, with 7 players on the court at one time, including a goalkeeper.
- Rolling substitutions are allowed.
- Only one team can be entered per school per category.
- The categories are as follows:
  - ➤ Year 7 & 8 Girls U13
  - > Year 7 & 8 Boys U13
  - Year 9 & 10 Girls U15
  - ➤ Year 9 & 10 Bovs U15

All teams must field at least 2 players of the younger age group. Eg Yr7/8 Girls two Yr7 girls have to be on the court

#### **Equipment:**

- All equipment will be provided by the event organisers.
- Ball Size: Size 0 (U13 G), 1 (U13 B and U15 G) 2 (U15 B).
- Goals will be Handball/Futsal/Hockey or equivalent.
- Participants should wear appropriate sportswear and footwear.

### Playing Rules Regulations: (From England Handball)

- Teams consist of 7 players (six outfields plus one GK).
- All teams must field at least 2 players of the younger age group. Eg Yr7/8 Girls two Yr7 girls have to be on the
- Players are interchangeable at any time during the game.
- Size 0 handballs should be used for U13 girl's competition.
- Size 1 handballs should be used for U15 girls and U13 boy's competition and size 2 for U15 Boys.
- Matches should be 10 minutes straight through.
- One referee is required on court this can be a teacher/leader or qualified handball referee.
- The referee, or preferably table officials, will be responsible for scorekeeping and timekeeping.
- 3 points will be awarded for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss.
- In the event of a tie in any league table positions, winners will be decided in this order; on goal difference, goals scored, the result of matches between tied teams, goals against and ultimately a five attempt penalty shootout. If it is still tied penalties will continue as sudden death.
- In any play-off games a tie at full-time will result in two minutes of extra-time. If the game is still tied after extratime, each team will take five penalties, and if it remains a tie after five attempts, there will be sudden-death penalties.
- No gloves or gym mats.
- Progressive punishment will result in a 1-minute sin bin where appropriate.
- You are not allowed to pass back to the goalkeeper when they are in their 6m area.
