BASIC RULES

Handle only one stack at a time You must always go back to the beginning to down stack Fix your fumbles immediately when they happen

One person uses their right hand and the other person uses their left hand to upstack and downstack 3.6.3. See the 4th photo down on the right.

RELAY

The Lead Stacker on the team starts at the Stack Mat® on the competition table. The other three Stackers on the starting line, 1.5 m (5 ft.) back from the edge of the table, and facing the back of the Lead Stacker. After each Stacker tags their team mate, they return to the end of the line. The final Stacker will stop the Stack Mat® Timer.
